### STANDING RULES Revised January, 2011

1. Monthly meeting to start **promptly** at 7:30 p.m.
2. New membership cards will be issued annually upon payment of dues.
3. Club pennant approved - 1991.
4. Honorary membership awarded to Mr. A.E. Skinner as founder of the club - 1955.
5. Members of the Armed Forces transferred from this area are exempt from all obligations to the club until they return to this area. When they return to this area, upon payment of current dues, they will be reinstated.
6. A monthly bulletin will be mailed or emailed to all members and to neighboring boat clubs.
7. The club will sponsor an annual Christmas party free to members and their houseguests.
8. Members not wearing plastic name tags at the regular meeting will be fined **\$1.00**
9. The renting of the club building is to be the responsibility of the Club Rental Chairman.
10. The Rear Commodore may use the club telephone for long distance calls for club cruises.

15. Galley Coordinator to be allotted a working fund.
16. All property donations made to the club must be passed on by the Property Chairman and the Galley Coordinator. The proper disposal of excess or unusable donations is to be handled by the Property Chairman.
17. All items such as copies of By-laws, copies of House Rules, copies of Standing Rules, Club pennants, Club stickers, etc. will be turned over to the membership Chairman to keep under his/her care so that he may have these items to present to all new members.

19. Flowers or another appropriate expression of sympathy, in the name of the club, shall be sent on the death of a member, spouse, or a child of a member, mother/father at a cost not to exceed \$50.00, as directed by the Commodore.

20. Gasparilla weekend will be observed annually with Buccaneer festivities including a dance on Saturday night and invitations extended to neighboring clubs.
21. Initiation for new members to be held at the discretion of the Membership Chairman.
22. Only, adult members have access to the refreshment bar.
23. A letter should be sent by the Treasurer, not as of April 1, but after the first April meeting to delinquent members not renewing their membership, requesting keys to be returned.
24. All flag officers shall be presented the appropriate flag of their office upon being sworn into office.
25. All children are welcome to all activities unless stated otherwise in the club bulletin as an adult function.
26. All classifications will be made by the Board of Directors, Legal age for adults to be 21.
27. Tampa Cruis-A-Cade Club is not to be responsible for any bodily injury or property damage occurring to its members or guest in or during any cruises or other events.
28. Open display of firearms, by members or their guest is strictly prohibited. Toy (non-working model) weapons may be displayed as an integral part of a costume appropriate to the function.
29. Club keys will be placed in the care and custody of the club Property Chairman for issue to new members.
30. The club will pay for the cost of film, and processing incurred by the "Club Photographer" taking pictures for the club at a club function. All negatives and photos so charged become the property of the club and placed in the custody of the Scrap Book Chairman.
31. Club members have unrestricted use of the club facilities, (restrooms, ramps, outside facilities) during club functions or rented activities.
32. Real property must be signed out with the Property Chairman.
33. Club Hostess will be elected at general election. Their duties will include
  - Greeting members at general meetings, having them sign in and collecting monies from those not wearing name tags which will be given to the club Treasurer after each event.
  - To send "Get well cards" to those who are ill.
  - To send flowers or appropriate recognition to families of deceased members and children.

At the discretion of the Board, violation of this rule subjects the member to immediate revocation of membership in the Tampa Cruis A Cade Club.
